ELIGIBILITY: All competitors must be a member in good standing with Judo BC or their respective Judo Association. **Proof of valid membership** may be requested at Weigh-In

Competitors must be able to produce proof of age, rank, and Judo BC membership, if requested. All competitors who are NOT members of JUDO BC must sign (or, if under 18 years old, parent or guardian) a copy of the enclosed "**Release and Indemnity**" form.

CHECK-IN: All U-9, U-11 and U-13 divisions do not need to weigh-in but must check in to confirm registration. Exact Weight must be submitted with entry.

VANCOUVER INTERNATIONAL OPEN JUDO TOURNAMENT

TOURNAMENT RULES - All IJF rules will be respected with the following exceptions:

- That rest between matches may be limited to a period equal to the division match duration.
- Divisions 10-100: "Headlock" throws will not be permitted.
- Divisions 10-100: drop knee seoi-nage will not be permitted
- Shimewaza and Kansetsuwaza permitted in Junior Men and Women, and Senior divisions only. Shimewaza only permitted in Cadet Men & Women. There will be no Shimewaza and Kansetsuwaza allowed in the Juvenile, Novice Cadet and Novice Senior Divisions.

ENTRY FEES and DEADLINES: CDN\$45.00 for all competitors. **Mail, Fax and E-Mail** entries accepted until **January 31, 2012** with **NO** late fee penalty. **There will be no entries accepted on tournament day.**

LATE ENTRY FEE: CDN \$55.00 for all competitors.

ADDITIONAL ENTRIES: Competitors competing in more than one division **MUST** pay an additional fee of CDN \$20.00 for each additional entry.

There will be an extra charge of CDN\$10.00 for those who fail to qualify for their weight division.

Note: Yellow belts may compete in the novice divisions only.

There will be no Novice Division in Junior Men and Women (U-20). Any novice competitor in this age group is encouraged to enter the Novice Senior Men or Women divisions.

Blue uniforms are encouraged for U-17 and above.

Winners must be wearing a Judogi to receive awards. Awards will be handed out after division final match has been recorded, while the competition continues. Females must wear a WHITE T-shirt.

The fees for **ALL** phone/fax/e-mail entries **MUST be paid**, even if the contestant(s) do not attend!

ENTRY LISTS: All entries are to state the following for each competitor, and the designated coach.
